Children from 4I certainly had a spring in their step at playtime yesterday and created some wonderful seasonal displays, see photos below -



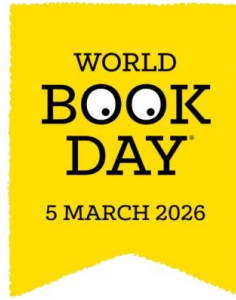
BEDTIME BAGS

YWJS is pleased to announce it is re-introducing our Bedtime Bags scheme as part of our World Book Day celebrations. This is where each class has its own bag, as displayed by Stella in 4I below, that a child is allowed to take home with them.

In the bag are two reading books (the person taking the bag home can choose which one they would like to read), a teddy, a hot chocolate sachet, a notebook and pen and some laminated instructions.

The children take the bag home for 2/3 nights. The idea is to encourage a love of reading and to spend time with family members reading the book, snuggling down with the hot chocolate and teddy.





WORLD Book Day is nearly here (Thursday 5th March 2026). Children can dress up as their favourite book character OR as an adjective (a describing word) e.g. they could be 'pink' and dress up in pink, they could be 'brave' and be a superhero, or 'sleepy' and wear pyjamas.

Those Year 4s going swimming should come in school uniform, with their swimming attire, as usual. But bring their World Book Day costume in a named bag, they can then change into this once back from swimming.

SCIENCE DAY AND FAIR

DON'T forget on Tuesday 10th March, YWJS will be celebrating Science Day in school, with exciting science investigations in the afternoon and a Science Fair.

Children are invited to bring in a science investigation tried or designed at home, or present or share something about a scientific theme they are interested in and have researched.

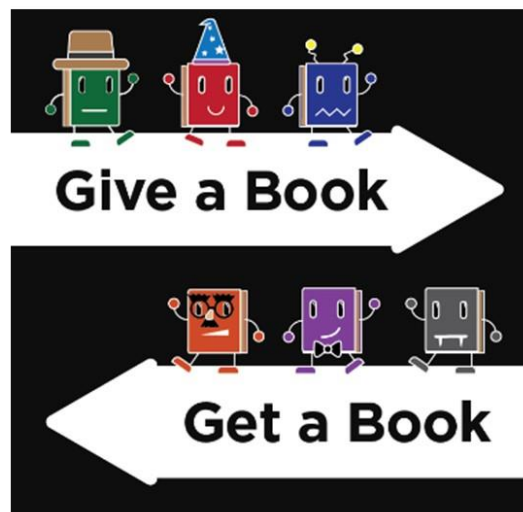
For example:
