WHAT ACTIVITIES ARE AVAILABLE LOCALLY IN THE HALF TERM HOLIDAYS...

THE half term holiday is nearly upon us and you might be wondering what activities are available locally across the week, below are some suggestions for free activities, so take your pick...

Leeds has one of the highest volumes of parkland in the UK and we are lucky to have Nunroyd Park, Springfield Park, Tarnfield Park and Esholt Woods on our doorstep! So you could always take your children out for a walk to explore one of our local parks, try and spot snowdrops or the wildlife there, some of them even have play parks. Even if it's raining, pull on your waterproofs and wellies and get out for some fresh air!



Slightly further afield, there is also Otley Chevin Forest Park, great for hiking and its panoramic views; Roundhay Park, one of Europe's largest city parks, featuring lakes, playgrounds and woodland trails; Golden Acre Park, offers circular walks around the lake, woodland areas and a café.

Yeadon, Guiseley and Rawdon all have fabulous local libraries offering a wide range of books, magazines and the opportunity to surf the internet.

The city also offers free entry to the following museums - Leeds City Museum, which has interactive hands-on exhibits; the Royal Armouries Museum which has a national collection of weaponry, live combat and jousting; Leeds Art Gallery, where you can explore modern and contemporary art and collections of British painting and sculpture in the heart of the city and also Leeds Discovery Centre, a state-of-the-art museum storehouse, where the team care for 1.2 million objects. From elephant skulls to a medieval log boat, mummy bandages and meteorites, the Discovery Centre offers a unique opportunity for hands-on exploration into the natural world, human history and ingenuity.



Whilst down the road in Bradford, you could pay a free visit to Bradford Industrial Museum which contains permanent displays of textile machinery, steam power, engineering innovations and motor vehicles; or the National Science and Media Museum which is a fun-packed, interactive experience; or finally the fascinating Bolling Hall, which offers a journey through the lives and times of the Bradford families who lived there for more than five hundred years!

Some of these Leeds and Bradford museums also have some wonderful paid activities on over the Half Term holidays, just Google the name of the museum and you should be able to find all the information!

Safer Internet Day

On Tuesday 10th February 2026 it was **Safer internet Day** across the country. This was a chance for all schools to focus on online safety and wellbeing of children and young people.

The theme this year was:

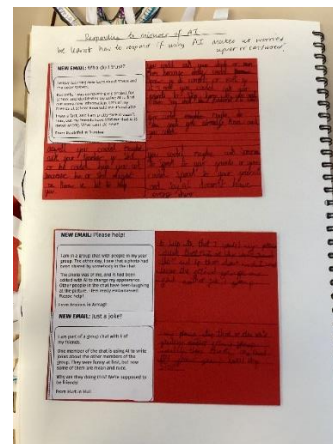
'Smart tech, safe choices - Exploring the safe and responsible use of AI'

On Monday 9th February Mrs Clarkson delivered an assembly about how to stay safe online and introduced the children to exploring the safe and responsible use of AI.

On Tuesday 10th February all children took part in a number of activities to explore the use of AI. They were given different scenarios and asked if they thought this was okay or not okay. They then used role play to act out what they would do if they felt someone was misusing AI and who to go to for help.

Later that day, children across the school took part in a BBC Teach Live Lesson where they learnt to:

- Use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly and recognise unacceptable behaviour.
- Use digital technologies to search, access and retrieve information and understand that not all of the information will be credible.
- Explore and experiment with digital technologies and use them to enhance learning.
- Identify and assess risks.
- Explain the importance of accurate and reliable data.
- Know when and where to seek help.

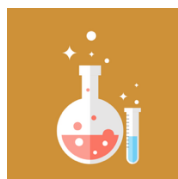

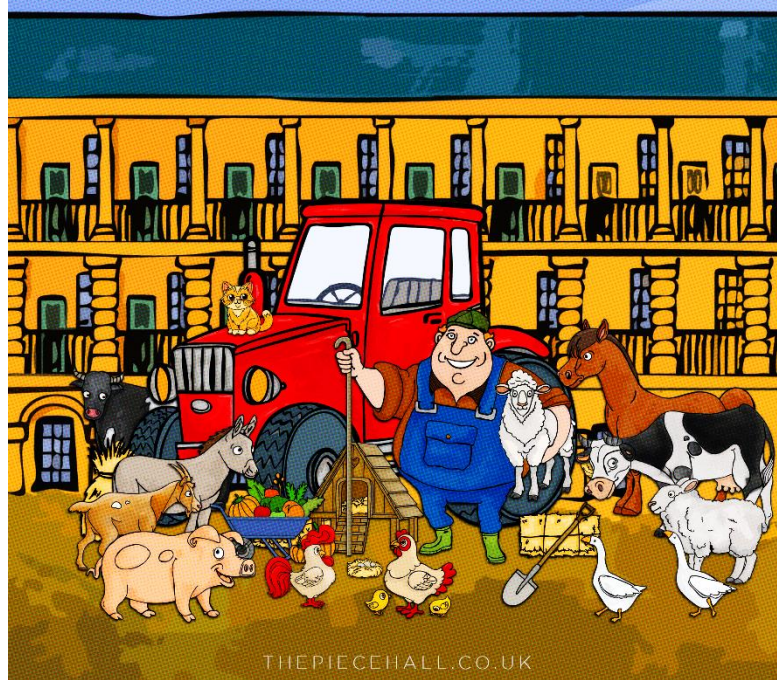
