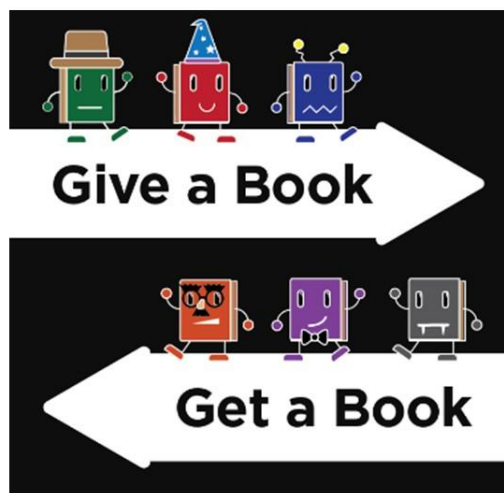

Well Done to all involved.

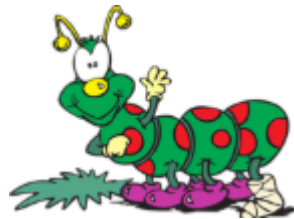

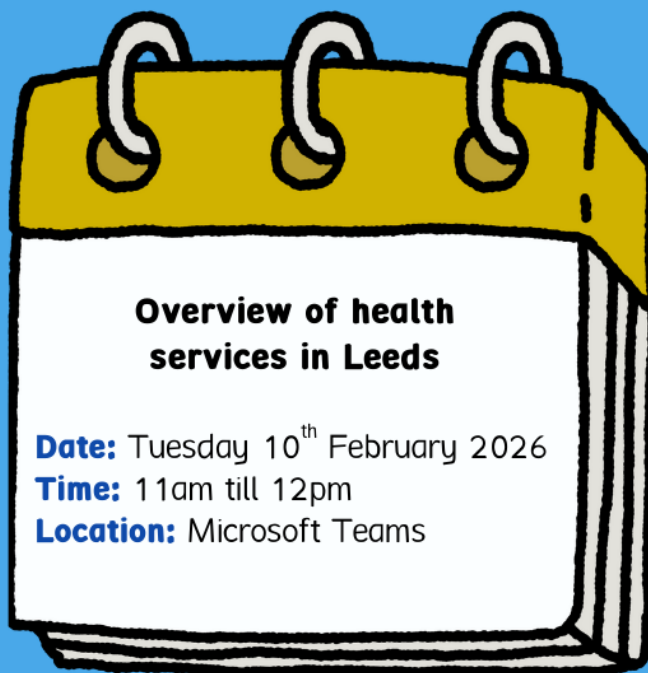
