☀ Burns and Bonfire Safety - First Aid Tips for Families

Halloween and Bonfire Night are exciting, but accidents can happen fast. Here are two key things every family should know 🖱

💧 For burns: **Cool, Call, Cover**

Cool the burn under cool running water for at least 20 minutes (about 3 episodes of Bluey!).

Call for medical help if it's larger than a 50p piece, or on the palm or across a joint.

Cover with clingfilm (in loose strips) **after cooling** to protect from infection.

💧 If clothing catches fire: **Stop, Drop and Roll**

Stop moving, **drop** to the ground, and **roll** to smother the flames — a simple, lifesaving skill for all ages.

First Aid for Burns



The Three C's



Cool the burn with running cool tap water for 20 minutes if within 3 hours of burn injury. Remove any jewellery, nappies or clothing surrounding the burn



Call for help - call 111 for advice, or in an emergency call 999



Cover the cooled burn with loose clingfilm or a clean, non-fluffy cloth. Warm the patient.



Do not apply:

- Ice
- Butter
- Toothpaste
- Creams
- Bandages
- Oils
