This evening is designed to provide you with essential information and answer any questions you may have regarding **Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)** support at Guisseley School.

We will focus on key topics, including:

- **Understanding the Shift:** Highlighting the differences between SEND support in a primary setting and a large mainstream secondary setting.
- **The Guisseley SEND Offer:** A clear outline of how Guisseley School supports students within the mainstream school environment.
- **The EHCP Process:** An overview of the **Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)** review and transfer process.
- **Current SEND Guidance:** General updates and guidance relevant to the current landscape of SEND provision.

This session is suitable for parents and professionals who are currently supporting children and young people to develop healthy friendships and relationships. We will be exploring the factors that can present challenges for autistic and ND children and young people and how to effectively promote positive social inclusion, consent and how to navigate the social world safely in the early years through to early adulthood. We will be exploring and sharing key resources and approaches to promote healthy social opportunities for children and young people.
