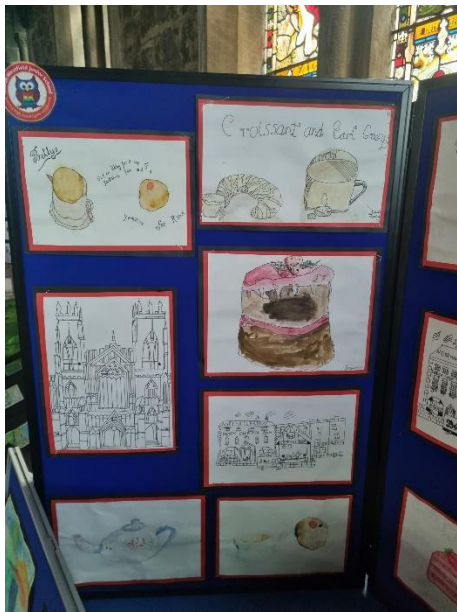
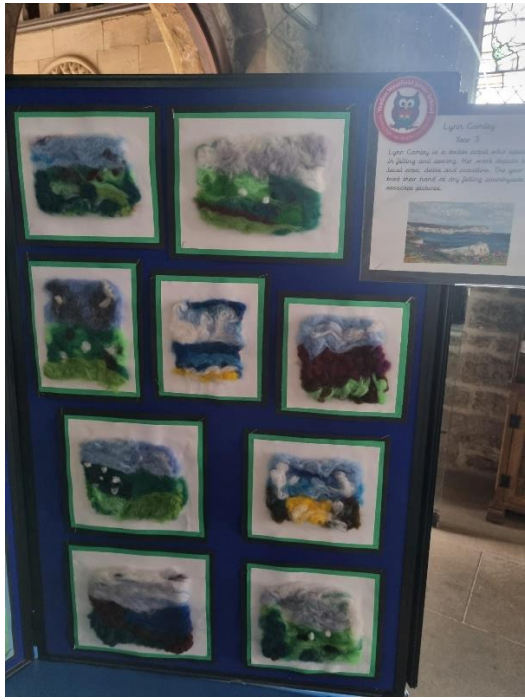

DON'T forget this Saturday sees the launch of this year's [Summer Reading Challenge](#) in all libraries across Leeds. The theme this year is Story Garden and is all about the outdoors, which is full of enchanting words, all kinds of creatures and plants, and fascinating facts - get ready for a book-borrowing adventure! Children will be able to find new reads linked to nature and access activities at the library - and best of all, it is completely FREE!

It starts Saturday 5th July and children can read anything they like - stories, poetry, fact books, graphic novels or listen to audiobooks - it's up to them! The books (physical or digital) can be borrowed from the library and we recommend reading at least six books over the summer, with Story Garden rewards on offer throughout the challenge. 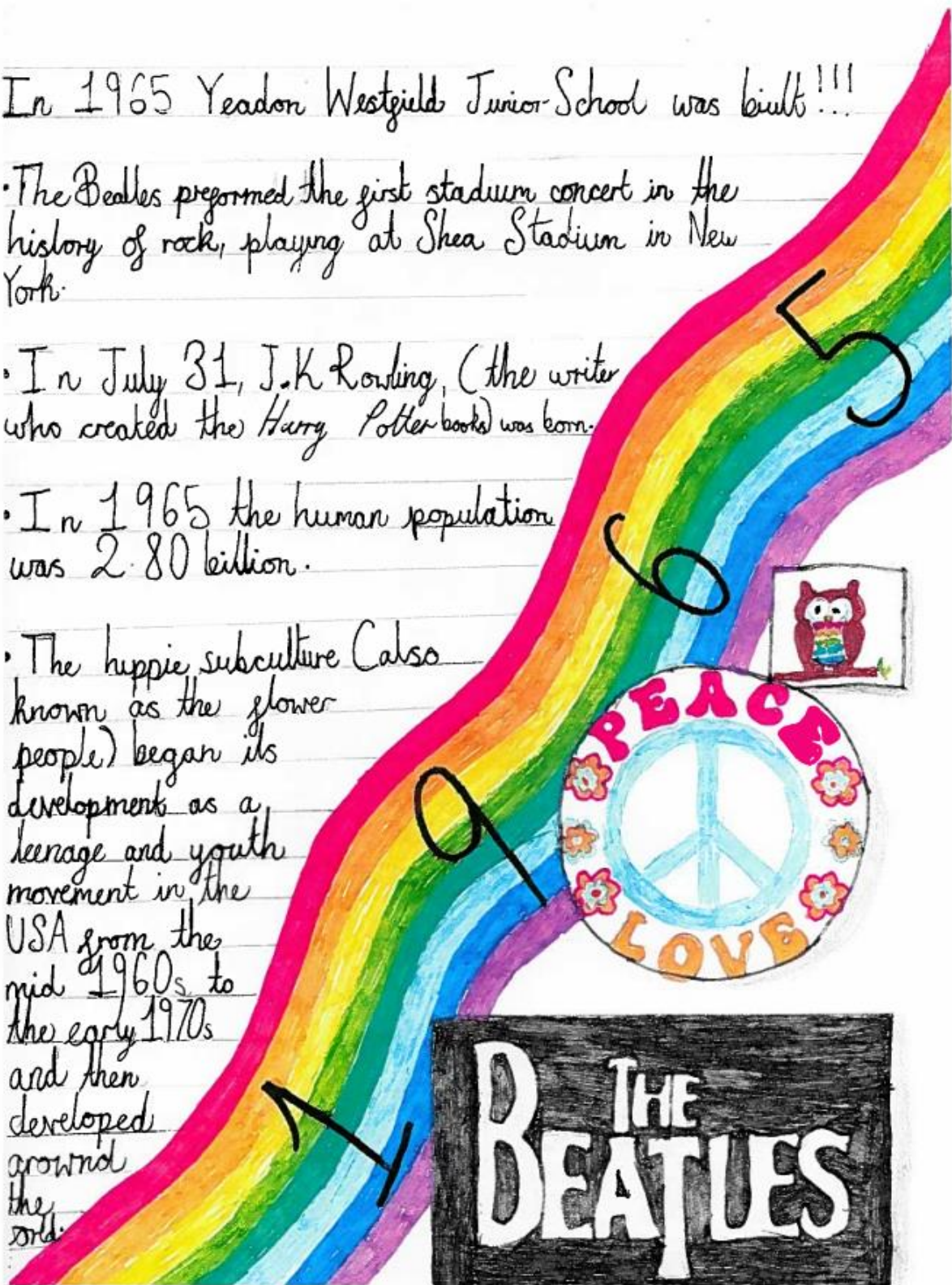
In 1965 Yeadon Westfield Junior School was built!!!

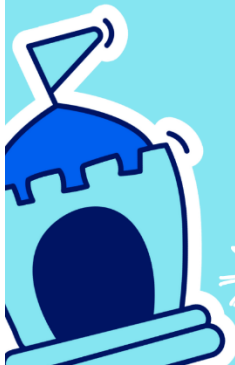
