HELPING HEDGEHOGS

In this week of Bonfire Night I have held assemblies looking at how we can help hedgehogs and other wildlife in our environment. I know some of the nurture group children are also learning about this. We have talked about ways to support hedgehogs in our gardens such as checking log piles, making escape ramps for ponds, making hedgehog highways and taking care when disposing of litter. "The Littlest Hoglet" on UTube has a series of short videos telling the adventures of a family of hedgehogs and the hazards they come across. We watched these in assembly, but some children who have a Nesy intervention at this time may like to watch them at home if they missed the assembly.

I also told the children about a site called Hedgehogstreet.org. There is an interactive map where people can log any sightings of Hedgehogs using their postcode. In assembly we had a look at the local area and where Hedgehogs had been seen and mapped. If any children would like to log any sightings it is a fun thing to do and also helps with local map skills.

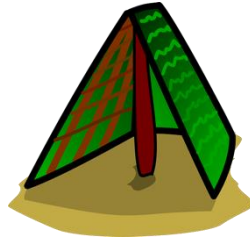
