GET INVOLVED WITH THE BBCs 500 WORDS COMPETITION

The BBC 500 Words competition was created as a way of encouraging young people to develop their writing skills and foster a love for storytelling.

With two age categories 5 to 7-year-olds and 8 to 11-year-olds, children are invited to write a story, in no more than 500 words, they would like to read. It's all about creativity, imagination and originality: spelling, punctuation and grammar are not marked.

The chosen finalists will be invited to a star-studded grand final in February next year where the bronze, silver and gold winners in each category will have their stories read out by celebrities. They will also take home an illustration of their story by top children's illustrators, a bundle of books for themselves and the gold winners will be revealed on World Book Day 2025.

Every story which is submitted (excluding the winners) will be entered into a random draw and one child will be invited to the final, along with their parent/carer. They will also receive a bundle of books and their school will receive 500 books.

The competition opens on **Tuesday 24th September until 9pm on Friday 8th November 2024.**

Any YWJS entrants should hand their completed, no more than 500-word, stories to Miss Whitaker in Year 4. She will then send them off.

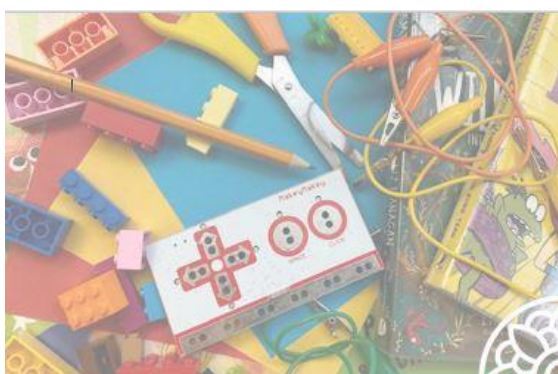

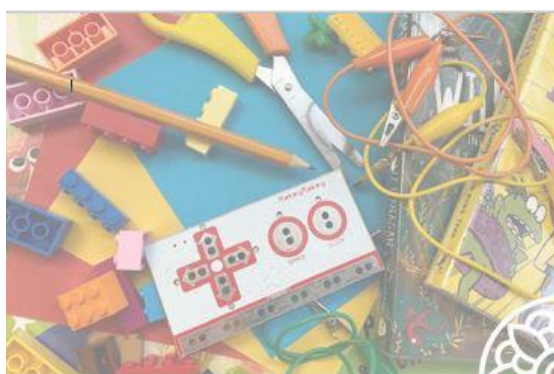

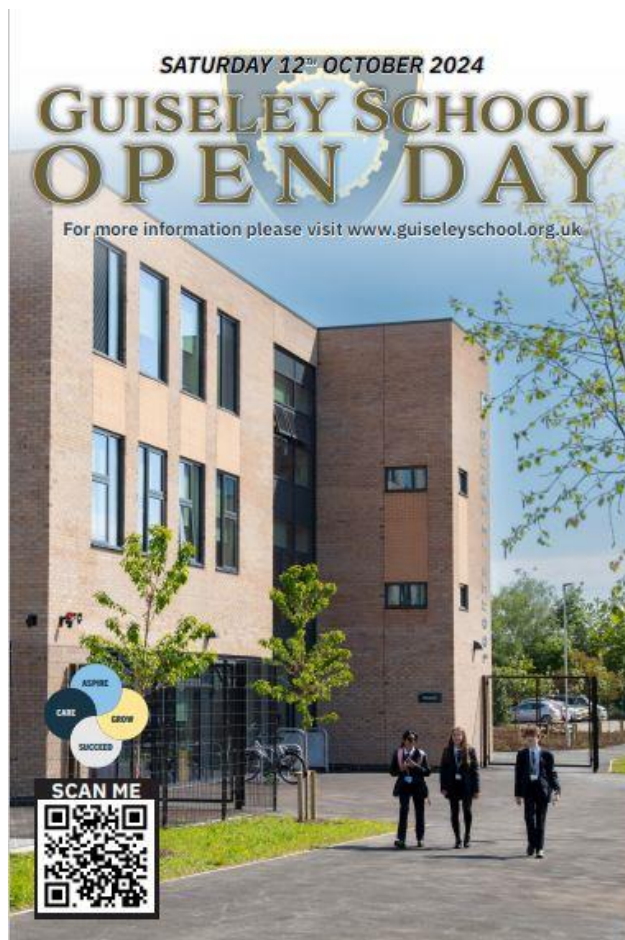
