Leeds Museums and Galleries

There's lots going on in museums across the city. We've selected some highlights, unless it says otherwise, all are free and you don't need to book.

- **Abbey House Museum:** [Summer of Stories](#). Seek out fairytales, nursery rhymes, and modern classic. You might bump into a troll, find the bottom of a beanstalk, smell some gingerbread or have a tea party with a tiger! Included in admission.
- **Kirkstall Abbey:** [urban nature trail](#). The popular trail is back with lots of birds, bees, bats and butterflies hidden all over the abbey. Walk through the ruins and along the banks of the River Aire while you spot the wildlife!
- **Leeds City Museum:** [token treasure hunt](#). Embark on a nostalgic journey celebrating classic board game tokens in our summer trail! Search the museum for oversized game pieces, from the iconic Monopoly top hat to a 12-sided dice.
- **Leeds Discovery Centre:** [summer store tours](#). Leeds Discovery Centre is home to over 1.3 million objects, most of which are not currently on display. Join one of their tours to see the real life behind the scenes at the museum! Free, booking required and only available on specific dates.
- **Leeds Industrial Museum:** [nature trail](#). Get your magnifying glasses at the ready as you hunt for the wildlife that has found its way into the museum. Join the family nature trail to see how many you can spot, then take away a craft to do at home! Included in admission.
- **Lotherton:** [a Lotherton summer holiday](#) You're guaranteed a jolly holiday with Lotherton this summer, with family activities inspired by the seaside and all things great British summer. There will be a sand pit, entertainers and family activities – including foot golf, a children's fairground and entertainers. Included in admission.
