Information for parents from Governors

Before we finish for the summer holidays, I'm contacting you to let you know our plans for September when children return to school.

As you can imagine, the timing of the decision to amalgamate the Infants and the Juniors has meant that certain things will not be decided or resolved before we finish for the summer or in some cases, before September.

A couple of things are clear: we have agreed that the school will be called Yeadon Primary School and will, for the next couple of years, continue to operate from the two sites. We aim to establish a new website under this name to be ready for September.

We will be working on a logo for the new school, and until this is completed, it is unlikely that the signage outside both schools will be changed.

Alongside this obvious change, we're also looking at alignment in systems and processes so that even when operating on two sites, it starts to feel like one school for the staff and, of course, the children. To do this, we will be looking to combine the best of both schools.

There will be no change to the uniform until the issue of the logo is resolved, and even when that does change, there will be no expectation that everyone has to be wearing the new uniform. We will of course, communicate any of these changes to you as and when decisions are made.

Finally, there will be no change in start or finish times at each site to give parents and carers time to move from one building to the other.

The most important thing is that the amalgamation has no adverse impact on your children's education as they continue to soar high, reaching for the stars. The Governing Body is confident that this will be the case; however, we always welcome feedback from you as parents.

Both Ms Lowry and Miss Swallow will be at the school gates in September, so there will always be someone available to answer any questions you may have, and of course, you can also contact me or any of the other Governors.

I hope you all have a great summer.
