Great British Summer Savings - Sharing with our families on behalf of the Department for Education

Rising prices can make life's little treats harder to afford, especially during the school holidays when costs build up for families. This Government is determined to help and that is why the Chancellor has announced the Great British Summer Savings scheme.

Until 1st September 2026, the Government is temporarily cutting VAT from 20% to 5% on children's meals in restaurants, children and family tickets to cinemas, theatres, concerts and exhibitions and admission to a wide range of attractions. Combined with free bus travel during August for children aged 5 to 15 in England, families and young people will be able to enjoy experiences that make summer special, including visits to the kind of cultural and educational attractions that enrich children's lives outside the classroom.

As part of this campaign, an attraction finder website has been launched, this allows families to type in their postcode and find participating venues near them to make the most of the summer savings. To use the attraction finder please visit

The Children's Commissioner is asking all school children to fill in a national survey, The Big Future, [here](#).

Dame Rachel de Souza, the Children's Commissioner explains: "For the first time, hundreds of thousands of children will be eligible to vote in the next general election at age 16, the biggest change to the franchise in half a century - yet just one in five children say politicians listen to them.

"That's why I'm doing my final survey, *The Big Future*, to talk to a million children, to listen to them. And to find out about what it's like to be a child today.

"I am asking children about the changes they want to see in their communities, their biggest concerns, and their hopes for the future. More than anything, I want to know what they think a good childhood should look like, now and in the future."
